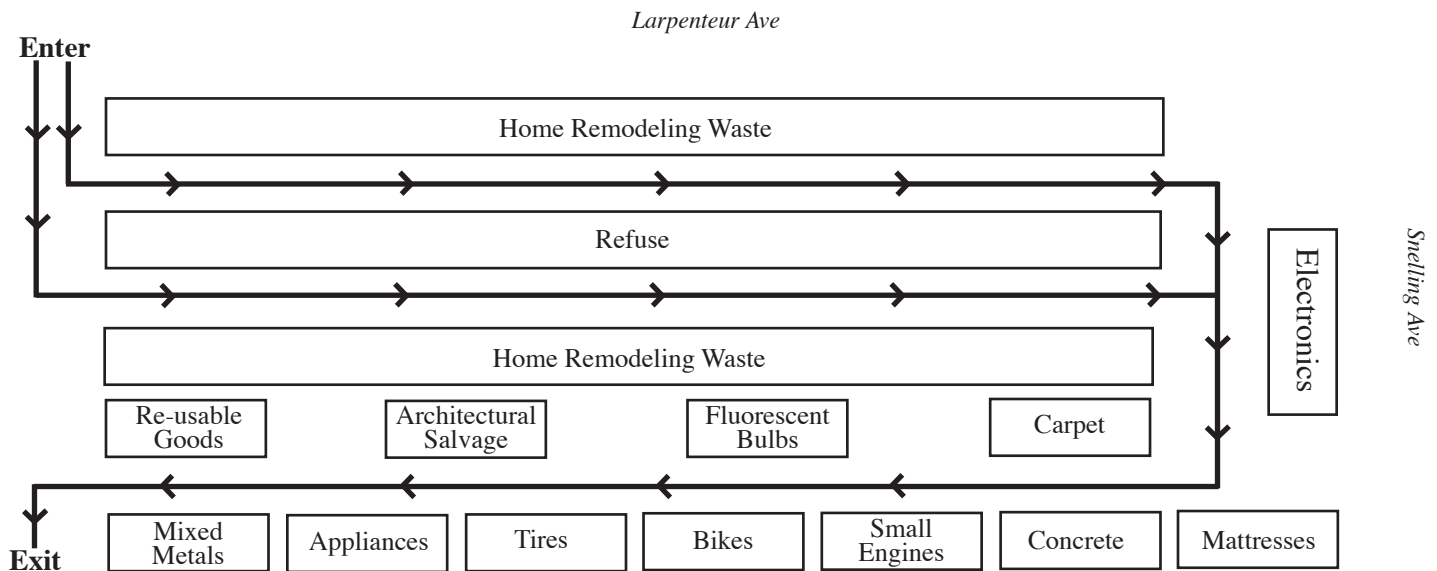

IMPORTANT!
The form on the back of this flyer with the mailing label is your entrance voucher for your neighborhood cleanup. Bring it with you on September 25th.



You must live in the Como (District 10), Hamline Midway (District 11), St. Anthony Park (District 12), or Union Park (District 13) neighborhoods or Falcon Heights to bring materials to this cleanup.

Use the diagram pictured to help you pack your vehicle in the order that items will be unloaded (i.e. plan to unload home remodeling waste and refuse before tires, reuse, etc.). All vehicles will be directed to follow the traffic pattern indicated on the map. For the safety of all, do not cross over lanes.

Bring the form on the back of this flyer to the cleanup. Fill it out before you come to determine your fee. If you do not have the form, you will be asked for proof of residency. Fees will be checked and accepted at the entrance gate. **Make checks payable to the Hamline Midway Coalition.**

You are responsible for unloading your own vehicle at the appropriate collection sites. Volunteers will be on site to assist you. Do not walk inside any dumpster or throw anything over the sides of dumpsters unless the door is closed.
