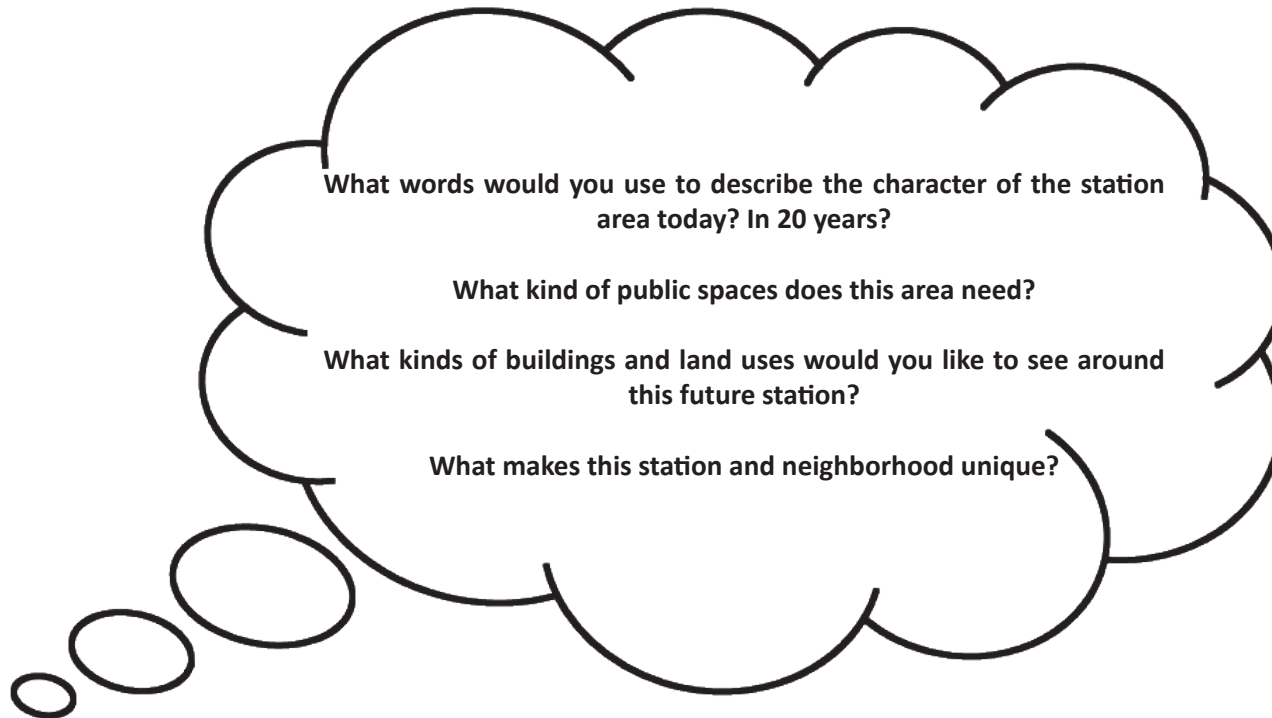




# central corridor station area planning
