Any new route needs to connect NSAP to the green line and go by the U.
reconstruction	TTASAP is working in a plan for 2040. They are working on a transportation section currently. Pat will send us a copy soon.
	UMN, Ramsey County, and City of St. Paul are working on seeing where there there can be an off street bike path on Cleveland as it gets reconstructed. There are several logistical issues but it is still possible. Les recommends that we stay involved in this process.
