We discussed that people seemed to really like the Afro Deli meals and they would be a good one to partner with again. The boxed meal format doesn't allow for a lot of relationship building, but worked well and some people did stay and eat. Discussed another community meal before the Innovation Funds ran out. While Seal would likely be open to doing a community meal event, the committee was not sure that it was ready to do that due to Covid. Maybe this spring/summer.

Discussed what to do with the extra funds and decided to donate it to Brightside as sponsorship money for their pay what you can programming. Voted - all in favor, no opposed, no abstentions.

Members expressed wanting to support them in any way we can - maybe doing a community meal/event for them this summer. Hoping to do a meeting at Union Flats this summer.

Goal #1

Foster coalition building to meet community needs within the district and across districts.

How might we do this?

- Quarterly Community Conversations host meetings or events that connect community organizations with residents that can benefit from their work or expertise.
- Continue to partner with Brightside Produce to encourage community produce subscription and connect neighbors in need with pay-what-you-can options
- Continued partnerships with the Community Garden delivering produce to the Seal Hi-Rise
- Community meals with Seal Hi-Rise, Union Flats, or other communities
 - Early February
 - Late May
 - Early Summer (with NNO?)
 - Focus on meals in outdoor months to safely gather outside?
- Support creative, approachable public events that bring awareness of diversity and equity issues in the community

Goal #2

Actively recruit and broaden diversity on the Equity Committee so that we're more representative of the neighborhood.

How might we do this?

- Make meetings more accessible to diverse communities by advertising the meetings and hosting them at Seal Hi-Rise, Union Flats or in other accessible public spaces.
- Make meetings more desirable to attend/incentivice meeting attendance from guests/community members

- Leave an agenda item at the end of every meeting where any guests can identify a topic to discuss.
- Hold a committee meeting before, during, or after a community meal
- Provide snacks, food at meal if in person
- Follow up with guests after attendance at meetings
- Quarterly Community Conversations host meetings or events that connect community organizations with residents that can benefit from their work or expertise
- Support creative, approachable public events that bring awareness of diversity and equity issues in the community
- Conduct diversity, equity, and inclusion training among the broader SAPCC.

Group looked over the goals above. John stated that we should start putting together a calendar of events from these goals. Jessica will start putting something together and we will plan details at our next meeting. Hoping to be able to add Movies in the Park back in - looking to contact some of the former members for information on how that was done.

Javier wasn't able to make it to the meeting, so spoke more generally about the group and what it might look like. Agreed that it was a good idea, but need to make sure that we have a clear goal and vision for the group. Did get some feedback from the newsletter (people interested in it). Will Javier and maybe the district that started something like this come and speak at our next meeting?

• SAPCC Relationship with Police

Checked in with John about this topic - he has not pursued it, but the taskforce has been around for a while, so he will check in again. We're looking for some sort of liaison to talk about what has been happening with police reform in St. Paul. Usually Patty Lammers is the one who reps the police department, but doesn't think her job is to update on reform. Looking for someone to let us know what's happening.

• Keep St. Paul Home (ongoing partnership)

Update on Rent Stabilization. The Bill has passed, but the city is now responsible for implementing it, so we're waiting to hear how that's happening and keeping accountable for that.

• Brightside Partnership

Hoping to find ways to promote Brightside weekly produce subscription. Will include information at tabling events and in newsletter/bugle. If there are more ideas, let Jessica know.
