- Community Input (Jessica)

 - Committee recommended re-posting on our social media site
 - SAP Internet Service Providers
 - Discussed the issue. John said that if there was organizing around this, we would definitely support it, but that we didn't have the capacity to start something for this. Melissa recommended that we compile some resources in case people need help paying for these things this might include:

- Partnership with Environment Committee (Joy)
 - The Environment Committee is wondering if the Equity Committee would be interested in planning the grand opening for the Westgate Commons Park since it's a community building activity. They're looking for a celebration in May or early June.
 - The Environment Committee is interested in highlighting the history of the park (Native Land), signage and interpretive aspects as well as talking about putting together an indigenous art collective.
 - Thought of getting local restaurants the Lab, food trucks, or other coordination.

- Committee members were excited to get involved, but wary of taking over the planning of it because of capacity. Putting on another event (besides the Ice Cream Social) might be too much. We talked about having the Ice Cream Social at the park and combining the two, which would take care of finances (we already have funding for that event), but folks didn't know about having something planned by May/June.
- Jenn and Joy said they would be interested in meeting to talk about it with Jessica. *Later Kathryn said that she would talk with Land Use about folks helping out*
- Neighborhoods Now Grant Application Renter's Outreach (Jessica)
 - We submitted the application would help with translation, community meals, and with the VISTA stipends.
- Union Flats Tenant Meeting Update (Jessica/Jennifer)
 - Semi Trucks: We talked for a while about working with Transportation about the Semi truck issue they've been having. Going to talk to the board and reach out to Mitra to see if there's something we could do.
 - Flyer Issues: Flyers keep getting taken down have been doing door to door flyering.
 - Committee members wanted to know about meetings in advance so they could attend - will be sending them out as soon as we know.
- Church Leader's Meeting (Jessica)
 - Met with clergy from all over SAP they were interested in how folks can get involved from a volunteer perspective and also to see where interests align
 - SAP Lutheran has housing as one of their top priorities for this year, so we'll hopefully partner with them on the Renter Issues. They're also looking to have a Housing Forum later this year that we can be a part of.
 - Talked with Kerry from Environment about putting together a volunteer hub for folks to get plugged into.

 - Neighborhoods Now Grant: \$9,000 for Tenant Meetings, Translation, Community Meals, Flyer distribution, Renter Events/Forums

Discussed that a lot of this funding is for Renters Rights and how are we planning to expand that. Discussed expanding our Renter Organizing to other buildings, community meals, and translation and the role funding will play for that. Building the community so that once the VISTA is here there's a good base for that.
